Several Unlimited Bylaws

For bank reasons, we need to have bylaws for Several Unlimited. Since we're a small club, they should be pretty simple:

All officers come up for election in September. All members that have paid their dues can vote.

Dues are \$12.00 a year, payable in September.

The officers are:

- President – liaison with other clubs, plan events and activities
- Vice President – find meeting locations, liaison with other clubs
- Treasurer – manage the finances
- Secretary – correspond with members and clubs, obtain mail from the mailbox
- Webmaster – maintain the Several Unlimited website and Yahoo Group.

The President, Vice President, and Treasurer must be separate people. The other offices can be combined as necessary.

Budget expenses above \$100 must be agreed to by the President, Vice President, and Treasurer. Amounts under \$100 can be spent providing proper documentation (receipts) are presented to the Treasurer.

We can discuss the bylaws at the August meeting, and any comments or questions can be sent to the Yahoo Group.

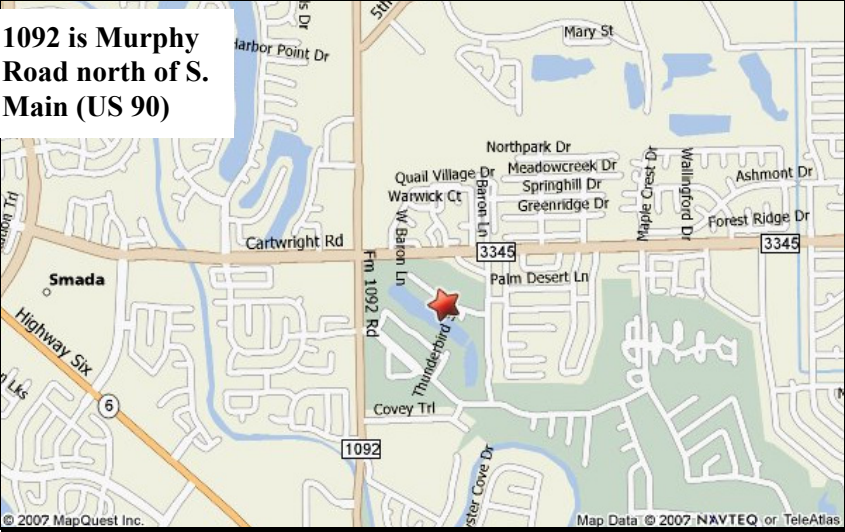
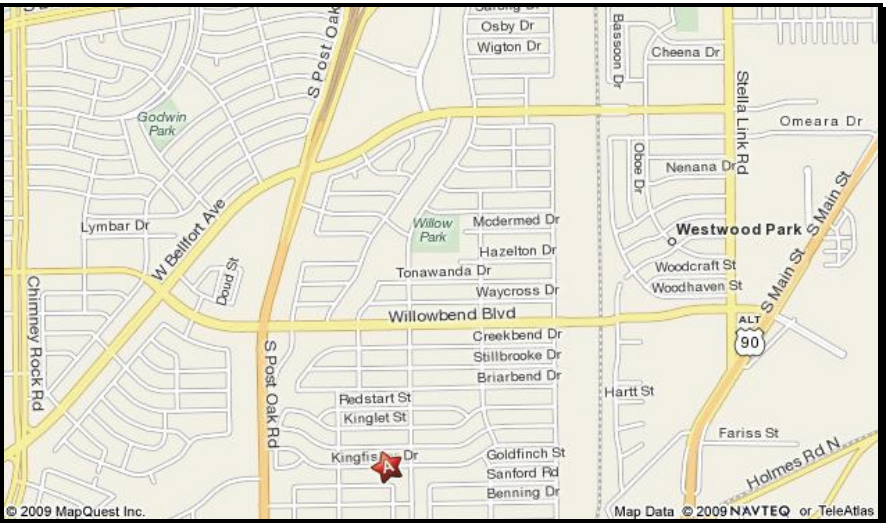


Figure 1. 3510 La Costa Dr
